Trial Test Windows 2024

IELTS Trial Test windows are

- 8th January to 17th March 2024
- 29th April to 7th July 2024
- 9th September to 17th November 2024

You may notice that we have moved from four windows per calendar year to three windows. However, each Trial Testing window has now been extended to 10 weeks to allow for greater flexibility.
